SAVOR THE FLAVORS OF MARTINIQUE

The cuisine of Martinique, with its unique blend of cultural influences, reflects the generosity and *joie de vivre* of the people who live there. Dive into the unique flavors of the island.

CACAO

Martinique is known for its high quality cacao, notably thanks to its soil, which produces cacao beans with a distinct and complex flavor profile that reflects the island’s biodiversity. Today, artisanal cacao farmers ensure that traditional knowledge and agricultural methods are preserved.

COFFEE

Coffee has played an important role in Martinique’s history. In the 18th century, a French naval officer brought a coffee plant from across the Atlantic and planted it in Martinique. Some say that 90% of today’s coffee can be traced back to this original plant.

VANILLA VOLKANIK

Exceptionally aromatic, Volkanik grand cru vanilla is grown using traditional methods at Petit Cocotier, a 22-hectare tropical farm and vanilla plantation on the slopes of Mount Pelée and the Pitons of northern Martinique, now a UNESCO World Heritage Site.



COD ACCRAS: SMALL BITES, BIG FLAVOR

These delicious fritters are an institution in Martinique and are often served as a starter or with pre-dinner drinks. Crispy on the outside and tender on the inside, accras are best eaten hot, dipped in the famous *sauce chien* made with onions, chives, parsley, infused thyme, chili, garlic, oil, and lemon. For a truly Martinican experience, wash them down with a *ti-punch*!



FORT-DE-FRANCE COVERED MARKET

It is one of the most vibrant and friendly markets in the Caribbean. Le Grand Marché Couvert, or Covered Market, is located in the heart of Fort-de-France. Designed by French architect Henri Picq and constructed in 1901, this bustling bazaar is where locals have bought and sold essential herbs, spices, produce, and other goods for generations. Visitors will find a variety of hand-crafted wooden bowls, traditional “bakoua” or straw hats, Creole dolls, and many homemade confectionaries that constitute an age-old tradition in Martinique.

THE RUM CAPITAL OF THE WORLD

In Martinique, rum is a culture unto itself. It is an integral part of the island's identity, and its roots are steeped in the first sugarcane plantations. Rum producers in Martinique are proud of this culture, and they are the only companies in the world to hold the AOC designation, awarded in 1996. The great names among them are known throughout the world today. While any rum in Martinique deserves to be tasted, most distilleries are also worth visiting in order to understand this incredible legacy.

SWIM IN TURQUOISE WATERS

While the south coast of Martinique is lined with white sand beaches, the north coast features magnificent beaches of silvery and bluish-gray volcanic sand, bordered by crystal-clear waters that stay above 77°F all year round. The coastline is accessible everywhere on the island and hides countless coves and islets that are sanctuaries for a number of species: a must for anyone who loves diving, nature, and tranquillity.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES



GALERIE DE LA FONDATION CLÉMENT

In the southeastern town of Le François, Habitation Clément is a heritage site steeped in the culture of Martinique and its rum industry. Formerly a sugar plantation, this 160-hectare property features an 18th-century Creole house, an old distillery that has been converted into a museum, botanical gardens, and a contemporary art gallery.

MUSÉE FRANCK PERRET, MÉMORIAL DE LA CATASTROPHE DE 1902

The Frank A. Perret museum commemorates the 1902 eruption of Mount Pelée, which destroyed the town of Saint-Pierre, with exhibits detailing this dramatic event that changed the history of Martinique. The oldest museum in Martinique, the building was renovated in 2018 and now boasts a striking contemporary design.

Located in a sprawling park in Trois-Îlets, La Savane des Esclaves is an open-air museum dedicated to the history of Martinique. It features reconstructed indigenous and Creole villages along with exhibits detailing what life was like on the island during and after the slavery era. Visitors can also tour Creole and medicinal gardens.

OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES



THE JARDIN DE BALATA

This three-hectare park holds 3,000 types of indigenous flora and fauna—including some 300 species of palm trees—just outside of Martinique’s capital. Follow the multilingual markers through Jean-Philippe Thoze’s landscaped gardens, rolling green fields, and ponds dappled with water lilies and lotus flowers. The suspended paths and bridges provide an aerial view of the gardens.

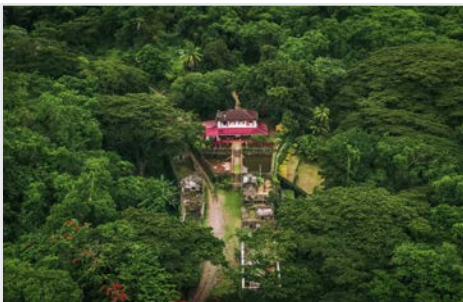
YACHTING
